The volunteer acknowledges the inherent risks of working with animals or in the vicinity of animals, and the volunteer accepts these risks. If the volunteer is a minor, the volunteer's parent or legal guardian agrees for himself/herself and the volunteer that they both release CAER and its directors, officers, and staff, as stated above. If the volunteer is married, the volunteer's spouse releases CAER and its directors, officers, and staff from all causes of action based upon or relating to the loss of consortium in connection with any injuries/accidental death for which the volunteer has released CAER and its directors, officers, and staff.
